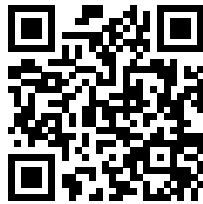

Solution: BFS visits each vertex and edge once, leading to a time complexity of $O(V + E)$, where V is vertices and E is edges.
