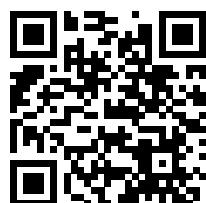

Q1. If you walk 6 km east and then 8 km north, what is your distance from the starting point?

- A. 10 km
- B. 14 km
- C. 8 km
- D. 6 km

Solution: Using the Pythagorean theorem, the distance is $\sqrt{6^2 + 8^2} = 10$ km.

Q2. If you turn 270 degrees clockwise from east, which direction will you be facing?

- A. North
- B. South
- C. West
- D. East

Solution: Turning 270 degrees clockwise from east will make you face west.
